Adult social care is the largest single expenditure area for local government, making up 39% of spend for authorities in England; this increased 62% between 2019-2025.

Our programmes focus on a range of areas, including:

- Prevention and early intervention
- Older adults' pathways through front-door and hospital discharge
- Working age adults - including those with learning disabilities and mental health - through transitions, and skills and employment enablement
- Integrated neighbourhood teams
- Commissioning and market shaping
- Whole system performance and finance visibility

Impact

- 40% fewer older adults entering residential care, and able to remain in their own home.
- 80% more people receiving reablement, improving their independence and confidence so that it reduces ongoing need by 50%.
- 39% more Care Act assessments, reducing the average wait by 16 days.
- 70% accuracy using AI to identify older people at risk of falling in the next year, enabling proactive interventions which have reduced fracture rates by 88%.
- Young adults being assessed for transitions over two years earlier, resulting in them needing 41% less long-term commissioned support.
